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
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
The redevelopment of Berninneit involves replacing the previous Cultural Centre to bring together the cultural and social aspirations of the community and draw visitors in to showcase the history and culture of the region. The new facility will encourage a range of community activities and events. The Theatre will be central to the engagement of the community and visitors to the area in cultural activities. Berninneit is managed by Bass Coast Shire Council who will provide a program of live performance including theatre, music and cinema; and will also be available for hire to commercial and community users.

I. Auditorium

The Theatre is currently under construction and will accommodate approximately 260 patrons. The theatre is wheelchair accessible and temperature controlled to passive house standards. The theatre also operates as a cinema as scheduled by Bass Coast Shire Council.

Dressing Rooms

Two dressing rooms are available.

Dressing Rooms Each Consist of:

- Capacity 4 People
- Includes Toilet, Sink and Shower

Green Room

The green room is a small comfortable room with kitchenette and a place to chill out.

Additional BOH Spaces

There are 2 additional spaces accessible for use for larger performing companies which must be booked at time of enquiry to ensure availability. These additional spaces incur additional charges.

Laundry

We provide a Laundry to all hirers to use during their show season. There is access to washing machine, dryer, iron, ironing board, steamer.

4. Foyer

The foyer has a PA system capable of making announcements, playing music and bells for audience. The foyer bar will open for all performances pre-show and interval at the discretion of venue management.

5. Safety

Test & Tagging

All portable electrical equipment provided by the venue is tested and tagged according to AS/NZS3760 Australian Standard

Any portable electrical equipment brought into the venue **must be** tested and tagged to this Australian Standard. Testing of a small number of items may be done by the venue staff by prior arrangement and **at cost** to the hirer.

Inductions

All hirers will be required to undertake a site safety induction prior to commencing any works at the venue. This site safety induction will be given by the supervising technician. Schools and large groups will be given a general safety induction on their arrival, this induction will be valid for the entirety of the hire only.

Wardens

The hirer's stage manager or a head delegate of the group will become the area warden for the BOH area. This person will be inducted on the warden procedure on arrival of their visit. The Warden will oversee marshalling their own company and BOH area in the case of an emergency and will be under the direction of the Chief Warden.

Company Attendance

The hirer is required to have a list of company attendees. This must be accessible by the hirer's stage manager or head delegate at all times.

Incidents & Near Misses

All incident and near misses must be reported to the Technical Supervisor/ FOH Manager as soon as possible. A Bass Coast Shire Council Incident form must be completed, investigated and submitted by Bass Coast Shire Council staff.

First Aid Kits & Defibrillator

The Theatre has First Aid Kits and a Defibrillator available in the event of an emergency. We also have staff on site that can administer first aid if required.

Any use of First Aid equipment must be reported to BCSC staff as soon as possible.

Fire Detection & Suppression System

The venue is equipment with a fire detection and suppression system, which cannot be tampered with in any way. Smoke isolation will be available for use of smoke and haze effects.

6. Sound Reinforcement

Theatre is specified with an advanced audio system sufficient for live productions and cinema presentations. All equipment is indicative, and specifications will be updated once finalised.

Communications

The Theatre is equipped with a hard wired and wireless communications System throughout the stage and BOH.

7. Lighting Equipment

Lighting Rigging

Clearance must be given by the Duty Technician after lighting has been rigged to ensure all safety standards have been met.

The theatre is specified with an advanced lighting system sufficient for live productions. All equipment is indicative, and specifications will be updated once finalised.

House lights are controlled either via the Lighting console or QSYS system located in various locations around the building.

8. Audio Visual Equipment

BCSC can provide audio-visual equipment to the hirer. All items required must be booked prior to your event to ensure availability.

9. Rigging & Staging

Rigging Equipment

There will be 15 hoists to make up the requirements for Lighting, masking and scenery. There is an assortment of rigging gear including, slings, shackles, clamps and pipe, etc. available. Any rigging must be discussed prior to bump in, and a qualified rigger employed to carry out the work where necessary. All rigging outside of standard equipment in the venue must be installed and signed off by a licensed rigger.

All rigging must be coordinated through and approved by the Technical Supervisor.

Stage Cloths

All stage drapery will be provided by the venue as per specifications.

Staging Units

Available for use: 6 sections Im x Im x 400mm high which can be joined make stage risers or platforms.

10. Access Equipment

Height Safety

All workers working with ladders, EWP's and other height access equipment must be competent and suitably qualified for the task they are undertaking. Any scaffolding over 4m (platform height) must be built and signed off by a licensed scaffolder.

The use of the EWP (under 11m) requires a minimum yellow card and a EWPA yellow card. Any use of a Boom type EWP or EWP that can extend above 11m will additionally require plus a Work Safe high-risk card (or equivalent).

Parking

Parking is available in the loading dock for 1 performance vehicle and behind the centre within the car park.
